


Cook Road, Bissonnet Street to Bellaire Blvd.

CobbFendley was approximately two months ahead of schedule in providing construction management and inspection services for the reconstruction of 9,000 linear feet of two-lane asphalt roadway to a 48-foot wide concrete boulevard roadway for the City of Houston. The project included construction of twin prestressed box beam bridges and installation of storm sewers ranging from 24-inch RCP to 8 x 5 box storm sewer, installation of 6-inch to 16-inch water lines and installation of 24-inch sanitary sewer. CobbFendley regularly met with the fire station personnel on the project site to minimize disruption to the fire department. CobbFendley also met with citizens to address and alleviate concerns.
